## Data Protection Notice for "International Ocean Governance Forum", April 22-24, 2020, Brussels, Belgium

Your personal data is processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725<sup>1</sup> on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data.

**The data controller** of the processing operation is Head of Unit of EASME.A3 of the Executive Agency for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (EASME).

**The legal basis** for the processing activities are - Article 5(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 because processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest (or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Union institution or body)<sup>2</sup>;

- Article 5(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 based on your explicit consent for your non-mandatory personal data indicated below; etc.].

The purpose(s) of this processing is/are to collect and use your personal information for the management/organisation of the meeting ("International Ocean Governance Forum"), including management of: lists for contacts, invitations, participants, reports, distribution of reports, feedback on reports, meeting follow-up, follow-up meetings, follow-up actions, information sharing.

**The following of your personal data are collected**: Personal data necessary for the organisation and management of the meeting, such as title/name/surname/organisation/type of stakeholder/E-Mail are **mandatory** for the purpose(s) outline above.

If applicable: Information about the form of transport used & hotel, and banking information (for purpose of reimbursement of travel expenses/allowances).

In addition, the following **non-mandatory** personal data are collected: *your photo*, *videos* and Twitter account if you tweet/retweet about the vent. Please note that the event may be partly web-streamed and it is possible that you will be recorded. It is also possible that photographs of you will be taken during the event and might be used for related communication purposes. Upon registration, you can give your explicit consent to have your images recorded and published on related communication channels. In the absence of your consent, the organiser will try to find suitable alternatives, so that you can fully take part in the event.

A participants list will be made publicly available as PDF on the events website and will include the following information: Title, name, surname and organisation.

Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organisations.

The processing of your data will **not include automated decision-making** (such as profiling).

**Your personal data** will be kept for a maximum period of 18 months from after the end of the event and minimum until implementation of the project contract. Data will be *manually* deleted at the end of this period.

You have the right to access your personal data and to request your personal data to be rectified, if the data is inaccurate or incomplete; where applicable, you have the right to request restriction or to object to processing, to request a copy or erasure of your personal data held by the data controller. If processing is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on your consent before its withdrawal.

Your request to exercise one of the above rights will be dealt with without undue delay and within **one month**.
